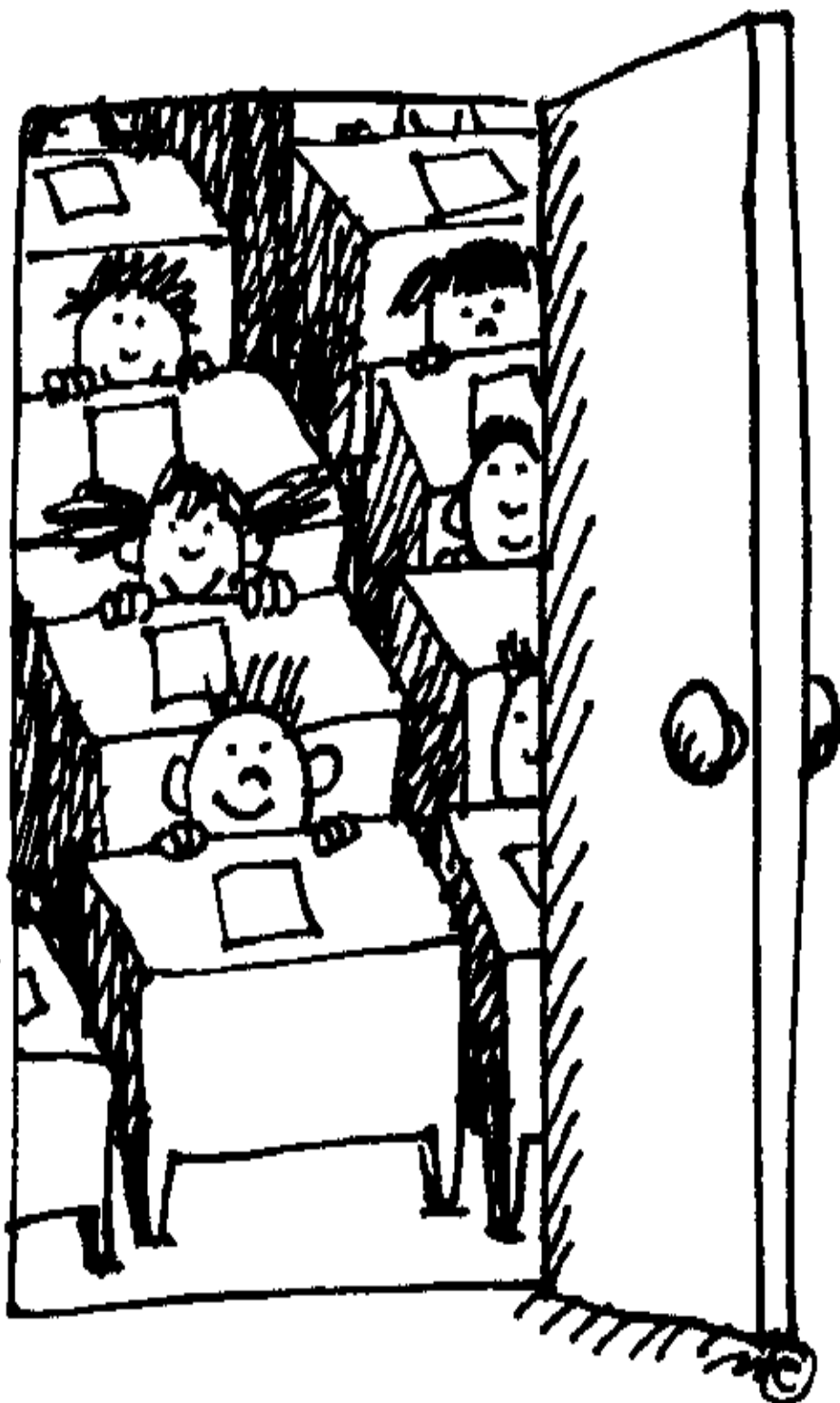

SMART TALK ABOUT SCHOOL REPORT CARDS

Ohio is lucky to have school report cards which parents can access online to better understand their local schools. But unless you are an educational stats wonk, the information can be difficult to understand. Here are some pointers for parents culled from StateImpact Ohio and the Ohio Department of Education:

Read beyond the first page

All schools in our state are ranked with six designations: Academic Emergency, Academic Watch, Continuous Improvement, Effective, Excellent and Excellent with Distinction. This ranking is a combination of four measures of performance, including whether kids are making a year's worth of growth. Many people never get past that single word descriptor. While a school's designation is important, we recommend reading a little more deeply into the report card before assuming anything about a school from a single word.

Remember that test scores are a snapshot

Test scores show a picture of a school on one particular day. They can answer some questions, but leave many unanswered. For example, how welcoming is a school? Is the principal accessible? How involved are parents? What challenges does that school face? Those questions and more cannot be answered by a report card.

Test scores also don't tell you the reasons for performance. For example, a school rated at the effective level can be doing a great job of meeting the challenge of closing the achievement gap between students of different backgrounds. A school not meeting adequate yearly progress may be dealing with many variables in students performance—some not controlled by the school itself.

Ask your principal to elaborate

In our experience, Clintonville's public school principals are the best source of information about their schools. They know the data and they know where their strengths and weaknesses are. Because of the multiple data points that go into the school report cards, it's important to go right to the source and get the inside scoop.

Learn the lingo

School report cards are full of terminology that we lay people might be unfamiliar with. Here are a few definitions to get you started:

Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP): A measurement defined by the United States Federal No Child Left Behind Act that allows the U.S. Department of Education to determine how every public school and school district in the country is performing academically according to results on standardized tests. AYP is a diagnostic tool that determines how schools need to improve and where financial resources should be allocated.

Proficiency Level: Score on a test at which students meet or exceed expectations for proficiency on each assessment.

Performance Index: A weighted average that includes all tested subjects and grades and untested students and reflects the achievement of every student enrolled for the full academic year. The performance index can be compared across years to show school achievement trends.

State Standard: The State Board of Education minimum requirement is that 75% of students are at or above the proficiency level on statewide assessments. The non-test standards are 90% for graduation rate and 93% for attendance rate.

Subgroups: Subgroups of students are grouped by a demographic or other characteristic, such as race/ethnicity, gender, socio-economic status, language background, or disability. Examining the performance of subgroups is a requirement in both state and federal law.
